***Oral Presentation Guidelines**

Oral presentations can include demonstrations of imaging lesson ideas, student or teacher research projects and results, and other issues relating to the use of imaging technology in the classroom. A Macintosh or Windows computer and a projector will be available. Proposals for both 30 minute and 60 minute sessions will accepted. You should allow time for questions during and after your talk within the specified time. Presenters will be introduced and time monitored by a designated session moderator. Presentations will be selected by a committee at CIPE. Those presentations that are not selected will be asked to make a poster presentation.

****Poster Session Guidelines**

Posters should be prepared for display on a tri-fold, science fair type of foamboard, approximately 36" high by 40" wide (90cm X 100cm). Boards will be placed on a table, with room for materials on the table in front of the display. Poster presentations can include displays of lessons you have developed, ideas for use in imaging, results from research projects, student projects, or images you have created. Posters should not need a computer or electricity. Please make the title readable from 5 feet (1.5 m) away, and text and illustrations clear and distinct. Poster boards will be available for set-up 1 hour before the session. Posters will be displayed in the hotel Atrium from 3:15 to 4:45 on Friday. You must be available at your poster during that time to answer questions. The posters will remain on display throughout Friday evening, and must be dismantled by 10:00 PM Friday.

*****Computer Demonstration Guidelines**

The Computer Demonstration session will allow you to demonstrate to a small group of people lessons and images you have developed. The session will be held in the Pueblo Room from 7:00 to 9:00 PM Friday. Please be available to explain and demonstrate your lesson for two, 20 minute sessions. You may want to provide handouts that enhance your presentation, but you should not give out the images in electronic form. You will be assigned a computer station and time period for your presentation. Computers will be available for loading your lesson approximately two hours before the sharing session.

We encourage all session presenters to make their images and lessons available for the conference CD, which each conference participant will receive.
